I. CALL TO ORDER

II. PURPOSE:

- A. Ordinance 2019-13. An Ordinance to authorize the town manager to convey excess real property to facilitate construction of sidewalks within the Town described as Beaufort County tax district 110, map 10, parcel 84A (Approximately 110 ft. on 11th Street) – (Sidewalk Construction)**

Ms. Linda Bridges explained Ordinance 2019-13 is an ordinance authorizing the Town Manager to convey excess real property to facilitate construction of sidewalks. This property is located on 11th Street and is within the Town's sidewalk construction policy.

- B. Ordinance 2019-14. An Ordinance authorizing the Town of Port Royal to waive the acquisition of certain real property, and other matter relating thereto. – (Waiver of Fuel Dock Conveyance)**

Ordinance 2019-14 is an ordinance authorizing the Town of Port Royal to waive the acquisition of certain real property, and other matters relating thereto. This is a waiver for the conveyance of the fuel dock. The port developers have a potential real estate transaction with a purchaser, and for this to occur, the Town will need to address the fuel pump area.
