This property is commonly known as the Port of Port Royal Tract, having Tax Map Nos. 110-10-183, 110-10-075, 110-10-079, 110-10-077, 110-11-249, 110-11-084, and 110-10-299, including a conceptual master plan of development and contains**

approximately 317 acres located on the Battery Creek, in the Town of Port Royal. Development uses for the property include residential, commercial, marine and civic open spaces.

- E. Ordinance 2017-20. An ordinance to amend the existing Planned Unit Development (PUD) governing the redevelopment of the Port of Port Royal.**
