"The Lady's Island Plan is a multi-jurisdictional planning effort to create a comprehensive vision for Lady's Island, SC. Beaufort County, the City of Beaufort and Town of Port Royal are involved in this planning process.

We held two public meetings (February, April 2018) and meet regularly as a Steering Committee and with member of the Northern Beaufort County Regional Plan Implementation Committee.

The next Lady's Island meeting will be to present the final draft of the Lady's Island Plan. This meeting is anticipated in late August/early September.
