Notice of Election | Town of Port Royal General Election

The Municipal Election Commission of the Twn of Port Royal announces the **General Election** for the Town of Port Royal to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017. Any person wishing to register to vote in this election must do so no later than October 6, 2017. The operating hours for the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Beaufort County are:

Beaufort Office, 15, John Galt Rd, Beaufort, SC
Monday - Friday 8:00am - 5:00pm

Bluffton Satellite Office, 61B Ulmer Rd, Bluffton, SC
Wednesdays Only, 9:00am - 4:00pm
(Temporary hours effective September 5 - November 22, 2017 Monday - Friday)

The following offices shall be included in this election: Two(2) Town Council Seats. This term is for four years and is a non-partisan election.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for one of the listed offices may file at the Port Royal Town Hall, 700 Paris Avenue, Port Royal, SC. Books will be open for filing at 12:00 noon on August 9, 2017 and main open during regular business hours until 12:00 noon on September 15, 2017. The filing fee for the office of Council Members is \$100.

At 9:00am on Election Day, the poll managers will begin examining the absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at 15 John Galt Road, Beaufort, South Carolina.

On Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 10:00am at 15 John Galt Road, Beaufort, South Carolina, the Town of Port Royal Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.
