Town of Port Royal, SC

The Municipal Election Commission of the Town of Port Royal will be conducting a General Election on November 2, 2021 to fill two Town Council seats.

Any person wishing to register to vote for this election must do so no later than:

In-Person: 5 pm, October 1, 2021.
Email, Fax, or Online: 11:59 pm, October 2, 2021.
By Mail: Must be postmarked by October 4, 2021

Candidates **must** be an eligible voter within the Town of Port Royal town limits prior to the date of the election.

Filing opens at **noon**, August 3, 2021 and closes **noon**, September 3, 2021.

Filing Fee: Filing fees are paid at the time of filing. The filing fee for Town Council is \$100. Citizens desiring to be a candidate for any Town Council seat may file at the Port Royal Town Hall, 700 Paris Avenue, Port Royal, SC.

Filing Form: The Statement of Intention of Candidacy – Non-Partisan form required for filing is available in the “Candidate Filing” section of the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Beaufort County website, <http://www.beaufortcountysc.gov/vote> and at the Town of Port Royal Town Hall at the address listed above.

State Ethics Filings: Candidates are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests and a Campaign Disclosure online with the State Ethics Commission at <http://ethics.sc.gov>. Failure to file these documents may result in a candidate fine but will not disqualify a candidate from the election. Contact the State Ethics Commission for more information.
